

University Parking

Frequently Asked Questions



Can I park at the university?

The university does not have parking available for students during normal working hours. Students may park outside these hours on the Brayford campus as described below.

When can I park?

Students may park at the Brayford campus using the Boulevard car park from 4.30pm until 3am Monday to Friday, weekend parking is available from 6am until 3am. There is no parking at all between 3am and 6am.

How much does it cost?

Parking within the times stated is provided free of charge for students displaying a valid parking permit. Application forms for permits are available from the Student Support Centre or apply online via the Portal the university's internal website.

What happens if I park outside these times?

Any vehicle parked outside of the hours stated will be ticketed and subject to a cash fine.

Are there any alternatives for parking?

For those students needing to park their vehicles outside of the hours offered by the university there are two reduced rate parking schemes available through the Lincoln Business Improvement Group and the NCP, they are detailed on the reverse of this leaflet.

I am a blue badge holder where can I park?

If you hold a blue disabled parking badge there are a number of disabled bays available in all of our car parks.

Schemes available to students

The Lincoln Business Improvement Group (Lincoln BIG) offers 2 options for parking in designated car parks in Lincoln city centre

Full Time Pass - allows parking for seven days a week 24 hours a day - the pass costs £53.17 per month (plus a £25.00 one off start up fee).



Parking Scratch Cards - allow you to park on a pay as you go basis. You buy a book of 28 Parking Scratch Cards for £81 (plus a £15 one off start up fee), then on the day you wish to park you display one of the scratch cards in your vehicle. Scratch cards are validated by scratching off the day, date, month and year, this is then valid up to 8am on the day after the expiry date.

These passes are limited and on a first come first serve basis.

20% reduction in parking costs at local NCP

The University has negotiated a 20% discount for all staff, students and University visitors at the NCP multi storey car park at the rear of Wigford House/British Heart Foundation (Brayford Street) near the Brayford Campus.

To benefit from the offer, drivers will need to obtain a ticket from the barrier entrance to the Multi Storey Car Park and keep your ticket with you.

Before returning to the vehicle your ticket must be validated at the NCP validation machine located on the front counter at the entrance of the Engine Shed/Tower Bar.

The Engine Shed ticket machine operates as a validation point for parking tickets, so drivers will need to validate their ticket before paying at the end of their stay.

The validation machine is located in the Tower Bar Foyer in the Engine Shed.
